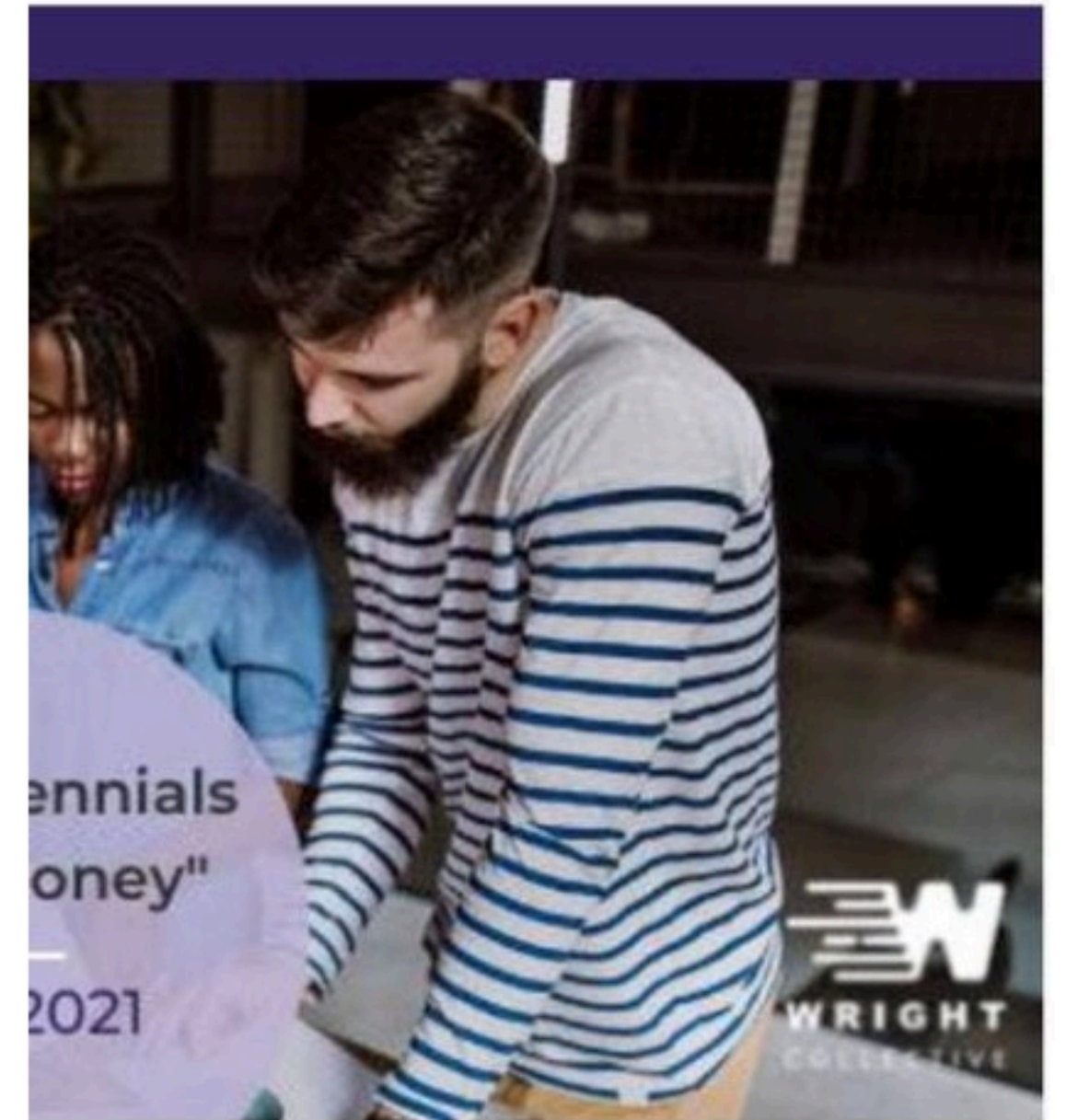


How are you feeling arriving to this course?

I feel that I don't give as much or as consistently but also feel differently after your intro.

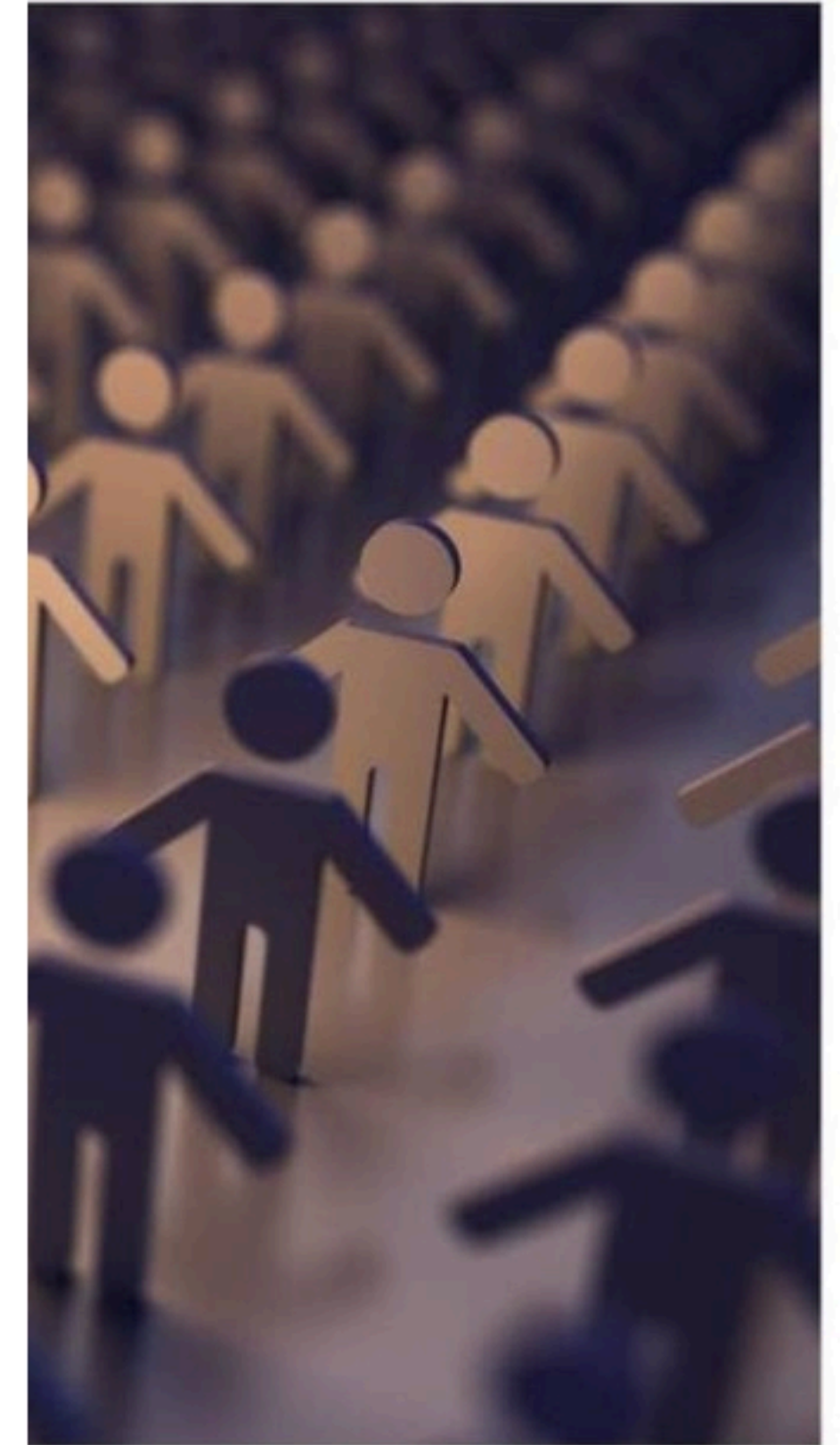
Not so much. Not enough extra income yet

I love how Millennials are reinventing this word. Good for them!

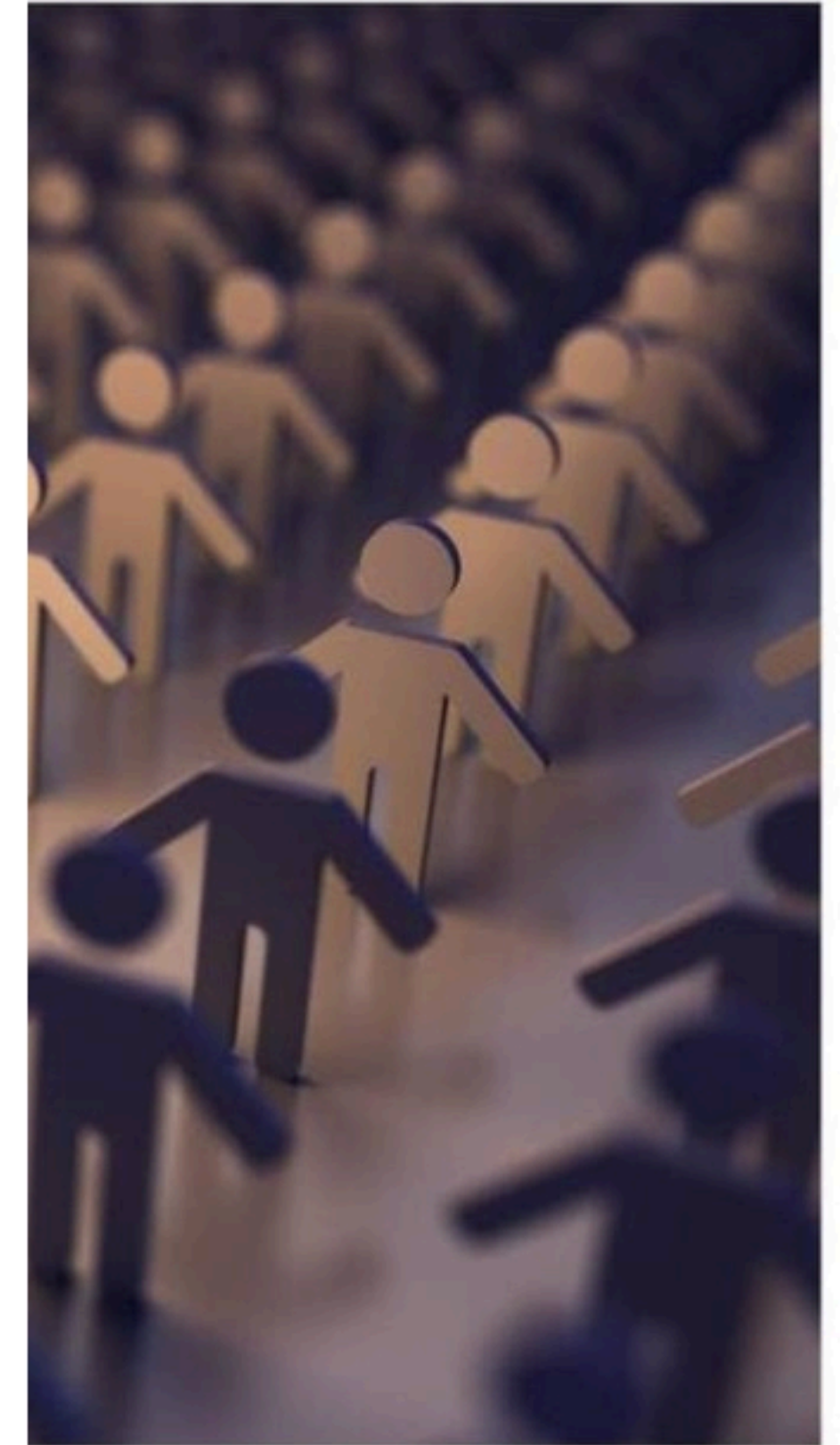
Yes. Can't help giving when asked to worthy causes.

No, I haven't considered myself one. I feel like I would say I'm more of a "changemaker" and philanthropist insinuates more of a giver

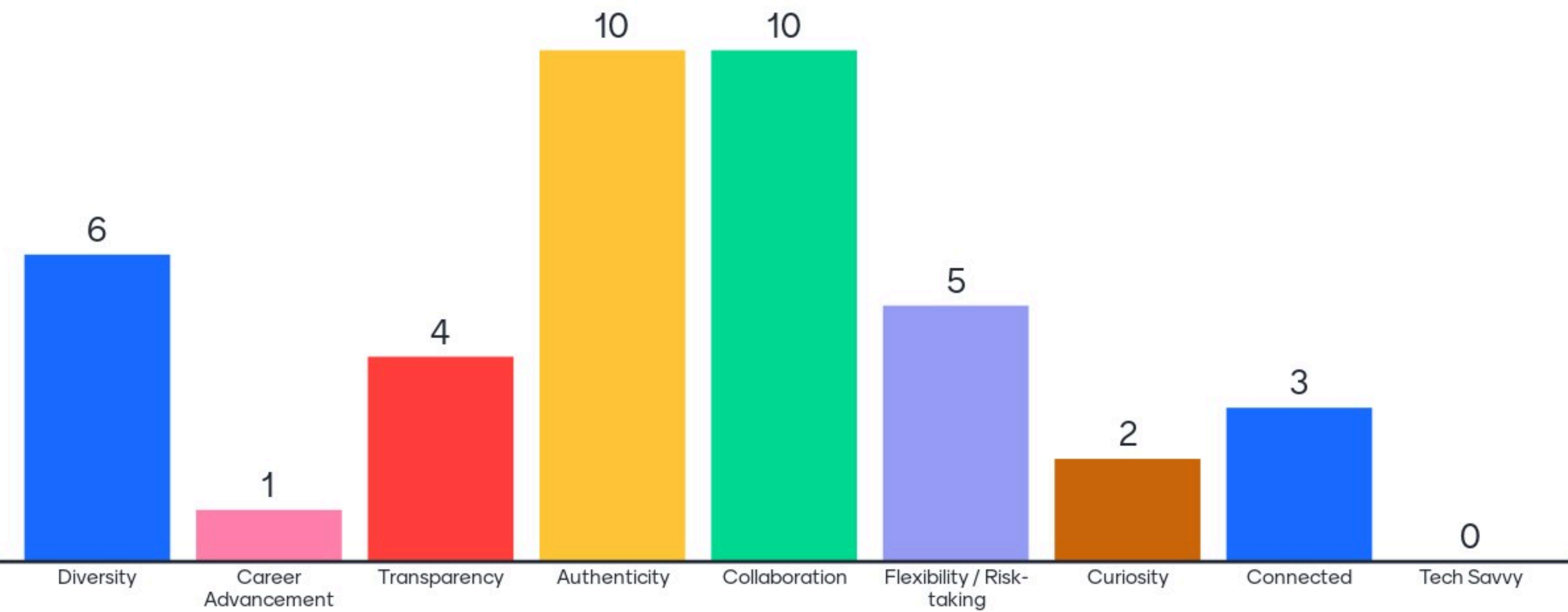
Yes I have considered myself a philanthropist since I inherited when my father died in the early '80's.
